Brian started his career as a dentist in 1983 until retirement in 2014. With no real plan what to do. he looked for artistic ways to spend his time.

Working with glass is clean, precise and detailed...

The perfect fit became working with clean glass, with precision and detail.

Glass fusing is the process of joining compatible sheet glass together in a kiln until the glass fuses up to 1490 degrees fahrenheit. Fusing glass offers a myriad of possibilities for creating both functional pieces and artwork with color and form.

Each piece presented is handmade in my home studio here in Desert Hot Springs and have enjoyed this hobby for some time. I also enjoy sharing my craft with others.
